There will be a do-it-yourself foundation station in the makeup room for those who would prefer not to use their own.

While it isn't a perfect solution, it's a solution that will work nicely if everyone cooperates. *Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.*

The makeup crew will be there for each cast member to assure that every one of you will be able to present yourself in the best way possible for your role in the Boar's Head Festival. May God Bless each and every one of you who have partaken in any way to ensure the success of this incredible event.
